Snežana Lakićević, PhD, graduated from the Faculty of Law of the University of Novi Sad in 1987. She completed her Master's degree at the Faculty of Law of the University of Novi Sad in 2007 and earned her PhD from the Faculty of Law of Union University in 2012.

She is an Associate Professor in the field of *Public Law*. She is fluent in English and has a basic knowledge of Russian. She passed the Serbian Bar Examination in 1994.

Since 2012, she has been employed at NIS Gazprom Neft as Advisor to the Deputy Chief Executive Officer. She is also the head of the "*Energy of Knowledge*" project, which promotes cooperation with universities and educational and research institutions in Serbia and abroad.

Since 2014, she has served as a member of the Management Board of the *Fund for Gifted Students of the University of Novi Sad*. Since 2015, she has been a member of a Commission of the Council of the University of Belgrade. Since 2011, she has served as Honorary President of the Gymnastics Federation of Serbia.

In 2007, she was appointed by the Government of the Republic of Serbia as President of the Council for Gender Equality. In 2010, she was appointed Director of the project "*Combating Sexual and Gender-Based Violence*", funded by the Kingdom of Norway and supported by the United Nations Development Program (UNDP).

She has participated in numerous international forums and served as a member of working groups responsible for drafting amendments to legislation and other regulations in the fields of labor law, employment relations, and gender equality.

From 2010 to 2012, she served as Editor of the "Employment Relations and Social Insurance" section of the legal and economic journal "*ZIP – Zakoni i propisi*" (eng. *ZIP – Laws and Regulations*). During the same period, she was also the editor of all publications issued within the "*Combating Sexual and Gender-Based Violence*" project and authored the foreword to each publication.

She has participated in numerous national and international conferences and is the author of more than twenty scientific papers.
